# Tynong Fire Brigade News

In case of emergency, ring 000



As I am writing this it actually feels like Summer! 34 degrees, strong Northerly winds, grass turning brown the lot, and off course last week we had the storms that have caused so much damage. Summer in Victoria!

Now something important. The FIRE DANGER PERIOD (fire restrictions). This year the brigade has attended more fires in the fire danger period than in any other year. This is very disappointing as the brigade take a lot of time advertising what you can or can't do with regards to fire restrictions. These restrictions are to protect not only you and your neighbours but everyone in this state (including fire fighters) so please make yourself aware of the restrictions by contacting the CFA on [cfa.gov.vic.au](http://cfa.gov.vic.au) fire restrictions and read the "Can I or Can't I" leaflet.

The fines, or even terms of imprisonment, for breaching the restrictions are quite harsh.

## **Brigade Activity**

As mentioned the brigade has attended several burn-offs or rubbish being burned in the open air in the last two months. When attending one of these burn-offs our members were threatened by the owner. This is unacceptable behaviour when our members are only answering calls from the public. Other turn-outs have included car fires, BBQ fires and fire threatening structures, in all over thirty calls so far this year.

## **Training**

Our new recruits are progressing well and should be available for turn-outs shortly. The rest of the brigade are taking advantage of the longer evenings training with some of our neighbouring brigades brushing up on some things that we do not have to do very often.

## **Other Stuff**

Our garden has had a lot of work done with extended car parking and new plantings, with some large rocks and new sculptures for decoration. Thanks to our garden crew with help from Terry, Phil and Hayden. As well as "beautifying" the area we are also helping our native wild life with food and cover and with careful selection of native plants for all the garden.

Before I go, we have just attended another outside fire during the fire danger period. The burning-off rules set by the Cardinia Council do NOT apply during the Fire Danger Period.



### Building Sustainable Roads in Nar Nar Goon

Sealing upgrade works are now underway on Dore Road in Nar Nar Goon.

As part of the Better Local Roads, Strategic Sealed Roads program, Council will seal the entire 6km length of Dore Rd.

Works will include road pavement construction, kerb and channel construction, drainage works and signage, and line markings.

This project is jointly funded by Cardinia Shire Council and the Australian Government's Local Roads and Community Infrastructure fund.

Dore Rd is the first project where Council has used ground penetrating radar technology to conduct environmental surveys and create a 3D model of the trees and their roots above and below ground.

With over 1000 trees surrounding Dore Rd, the GPR has helped inform:

The location and depth of existing tree roots

if road levels can be adjusted to avoid and preserve certain areas.

which tree roots will remain viable throughout construction and, which trees and their roots will need to be removed.

Without using the GPR surveys, it's estimated that over 340 trees could have been removed as part of the Dore Rd sealing upgrade works. Thanks to these GPR surveys, we have been able to save 95% of these identified trees along Dore Rd.

Bunyip Ward Councillor Graeme Moore said the project will play a significant role in building a better Cardinia Shire.

"The Strategic Sealed Roads program will connect vital local roads to the existing sealed road network, and not only aims to reduce environmental impacts associated with unsealed roads including run-off and dust, but also minimise the impact on native wildlife and vegetation."

"It's amazing that we can now utilise technology, like ground penetrating radar, to help better understand our native vegetation and ultimately help save trees and ratepayers money."

Council estimates that over \$300k in ratepayers' money has been saved due to the GPR surveys along Dore Rd, as it reduced the potential native vegetation offset and tree removal costs.

"I'm excited to see that works have started, and I'd also like to ask the Bunyip Ward community for their patience during the works," Cr Moore said.

Upgrades works on Dore Rd are expected to be completed by September 2024, conditions permitting.

The service helps Cardinia Shire residents to clean up and reduce the fire fuel load on their properties throughout the year.

Council's green waste drop-off events are accepting residential amounts of green waste including garden prunings, tree branches and trunks (up to 30 centimetres wide and 1 metre long), weeds, grass clippings, leaves, and flowers.

## **Award for the Best in Landcare | Corey Everitt (Pakenham Gazette)**

There is a new top award for the best in nurturing and protecting local bushland. The Golden Wattle Award from Western Port Landcare Catchment Network (WPCLN) goes to the most committed in local Landcare, and the most recent went to Tynong North's staple Gerry Cunningham.

The Golden Wattle Award celebrates as an annual award started in 2022, to acknowledge a significant contribution to the local environment, a tireless work in Landcare which often goes unsung.

WPLCN committee member Jim Armstrong presented the award to Mr Cunningham, its second recipient, who Jim has known for a long time. Seeing first-hand the level of knowledge Gerry has for the land, he is referred as a 'walking encyclopedia'.

"His knowledge of trees would pass any professor, he could list off each tree around, not just saying their names but their botanical names," Mr Armstrong said.

"We gave it to him because of 30 odd years in Landcare, both on his own property and he is a great supporter of others.

"For seeding and planting, he was always the first to help."

For Mr Cunningham, the award and his dedication to Landcare is a simple matter of what's right for the land and he appeals for others to join in this work.

"Landcare is about halting the decline of the natural environment which has been happening since white man arrived," he said.

"In many ways the environment is threatened, Landcare aims to protect, preserve and enhance what is left of it.

"Landcare is a volunteer organisation where people help to protect other people's properties and in return, receive help from other members of the network.

"We need more people to join us, especially the younger generation. Landcare is one of the biggest growing organisations in Australia".

Mr Cunningham grew up on a farm in Nar Nar Goon North, he has spent most of his life as a dairy farmer on his property in Tynong North, he is the president of Cannibal Creek Landcare and has been a member for almost 30 years.




