

**Information sessions for people interested in becoming councillors**

Residents who want to make a difference in and represent their local community are invited to consider running as a candidate in the Cardinia Shire Council election, to be held in October 2024.

A number of upcoming free information sessions are taking place during May and June for residents wanting to find out more about the election process and what being a councillor involves.

Two online sessions are being hosted by the Victorian Local Governance Association (VLGA). An in-person event is also being hosted by the Municipal Association of Victoria (MAV) in late May in Narre Warren.

The sessions hosted by the VLGA aim to support those standing for election to their local council or considering doing so. They provide an opportunity for people to find out how councillors represent their community and to hear from speakers with extensive local government experience.

Event details for the two VLGA sessions are as follows:

**Standing for Local Government – hosted by the Victorian Local Governance Association (VLGA)**

Friday 17 May 2024, 12 noon to 1.30pm

Online session via Zoom

This session covers the role of local government and what people can expect if they are elected. It covers how local councils work, the responsibilities of councillors and key issues to consider when standing for council.

**Local Women Leading Change – hosted by the Victorian Local Governance Association (VLGA)**

Friday 24 May 2024, 12 noon to 1pm

Online session via Zoom

This session is tailored for women candidates to hear more about what it is to be a councillor, through a gendered lens. This includes key issues such as the gender-based barriers to standing for election, as well as the importance of self-care and balancing care and work responsibilities. It also aims to encourage more women to stand for election to their local council, recognising the unique experiences and qualities that women bring to leadership roles.

A third session – available to attend in-person or online - is being presented by the MAV and hosted by the City of Casey at the end of May. This session is for potential candidates and other community members wanting more information about standing as a council candidate in the Metropolitan South region, which includes Cardinia, Casey, Dandenong, Frankston, Kingston and Mornington Peninsula. Registration for this session is compulsory. Capacity limits for in-person attendance apply. There will be no registration available on the day of the session.

**Community and Candidate Information Session – hosted by the Municipal Association of Victoria (MAV)**

Wednesday 29 May 2024

In-person and online event

Venue: Bunjil Place (function centre), 2 Patrick NE Drive, Narre Warren

In person check in time: Check in between 6pm and 6.30pm

Event time: 6.30pm to 8.30pm

Participants will have the opportunity to meet with council representatives from the region. Cardinia Shire Council will also have an information stand at the event.

The session will cover topics including:

- local government and the important role councils play for our local communities
- the role and responsibility of a councillor, Mayor, Deputy Mayor and CEO
- the election process and candidate requirements
- what newly elected councillors can expect soon after the elections
- councillor training and development opportunities.

In addition to the Community and Candidate Information Session, the MAV is also hosting sessions for women, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders, people with disabilities, youth, culturally and linguistically diverse and LGBTIQ+ communities. These sessions aim to support and encourage a range of diverse candidates.

Please note that the VLGA and MAV sessions outlined above are separate from the Local Government Compulsory Candidate Training – a mandatory online module for all Victorians who wish to nominate as a candidate in a council election. The Cardinia Shire Council election is being held in October 2024, along with all local government elections across Victoria.

Voting in council elections is by post. Ballot packs are sent by the Victorian Electoral Commission (VEC) to all enrolled voters to complete and send back.

To stand as a candidate in the Cardinia Shire Council election, residents must be enrolled as a voter in Cardinia Shire. Candidates can stand for election for any ward in the municipality – they do not need to live in that ward to stand.

## Notes from Cardinia Shire website (for more information visit [cardinia.vic.gov.au/burningoff](http://cardinia.vic.gov.au/burningoff))

The Fire Danger period has now ended in Cardinia Shire. If you're thinking about burning off, please follow the steps below. These will help you decide if using another method to reduce your fuel load is possible, whether you're allowed to burn off, whether you need to apply for a permit to burn off, and what conditions need to be met for you to burn off.

- **Consider alternatives to burning off first**
- **If it's a Total Fire Ban day or the Fire Danger Period is in place, you can't burn off**
- **If it's the month of July, you can't burn off without a permit**
- **Check which zone you're in (visit the Cardinia Shire website or call 1300 787 624**
- **Check the conditions to burn off for your zone. See table below.**

Zone	Conditions
Urban and Township Zone	You cannot burn off at any time without a permit from Council, which you can obtain online or by calling 1300 787 624
Bushland and Peri-Urban Zone	You can burn off if these conditions are met: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• On a Sunday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday</li><li>• Number of fires permitted at any one time: 2</li><li>• Minimum distance required from the edge of the fire to any buildings: 12 metres</li><li>• Minimum fire break size: 5 metres</li><li>• Maximum fire size: 3 metres in any dimension</li></ul>
Rural zone	Same as above, however can also burn off on a Monday

If you have a genuine reason for burning off, you can still apply for a permit to burn off

**Check that your fire will meet the conditions listed on the shire website (for example you must have the landowner's permission to burn off).**

### Register your burn off

Before you light your fire/s, you must register your burn off with an agency called ESTA (soon to be called 'Triple Zero Victoria') at least 2 hours before you burn, so the CFA don't get called out.

Registering online is quick and easy – it should only take you a couple of minutes.

Register your burn on the Fire Permits Vic website or call 1800 668 511 – do NOT call 000

### Apply for a permit to burn off

There is no cost to apply for this permit.

Please allow up to 3 business days for processing.

If you prefer, you can call 1300 787 624 to apply.



## Heritage Grant applications now open

Applications for the Cardinia Shire Heritage Grants are now open to residents until Friday 7 June.

The program provides funds to restore and conserve places of heritage value that are covered by a heritage overlay in the Cardinia Shire Planning Scheme.

Gardens, trees and hedges identified as having heritage significance, and that are covered by a heritage overlay, are also eligible to apply.

Cardinia Shire Mayor Councillor Jack Kowarzik said Council wants to support projects that leave a legacy.

A recipient last year, St Johns Church of England in Nar Nar Goon, provides an inspiring example of what can be achieved. The church's front fences and gates had been decaying badly. With the assistance from the grant, the construction of a new fence and gates in suitable heritage style was made possible.

The project helped to maintain the church's heritage value to the community, as well as support the site's delivery of community-based events, such as for music group and men's group meetings.






