




**Council adopts Honora as new suburb name**

**Honora** has been adopted by Cardinia Shire Council as the new suburb name for the area within the Pakenham East Precinct Structure Plan, subject to approval by Geographic Names Victoria (GNV). Honora received the highest number of votes for most preferred name during the community consultation undertaken between 16 April until 21 May. Other name options were Leila, Alice Park, Gwyn, Beatrice Park and Debra.

At the Council meeting on Monday 15 July, Council adopted Honora as the new suburb name and resolved to work with family members of Honora Carney and GNV to select a suitable suffix to the name.

Cardinia Shire Mayor Cr Jack Kowarzik said a new suburb name was needed due to the size and scale of the development area, which includes parts of Pakenham, Nar Nar Goon and Nar Nar Goon North and which is expected to accommodate 7,000 new homes.

'During the 5-five-week consultation period, Council received 1,840 valid responses, and Honora was the clear front runner with the highest number of votes for most preferred name with 636 votes, compared to 399 votes each for Alice Park and Debra,' Mayor Kowarzik said.

'Honora honours Honora Carney, who has strong links to the area and whose family still own land and live in the area.'

Honora Carney and her husband Michael leased a large parcel of land between Pakenham and Nar Nar Goon, south of Princes Highway, from 1869. They had 7 children and ran a farming business before Michael passed away in 1880.

Honora was determined to keep the family farm and purchased land south of the highway in 1887 and land north of the highway in 1902. She continued to run the family farming business with her children until her death in 1912.

At the Council meeting on Monday, Council also adopted the new suburb boundary, which will generally follow the Precinct Structure Plan boundary, with the exception of the northern boundary, which will follow existing property boundaries south of the transmission lines, as well as additional parcels of land south-east of Mount Ararat South Road, between Princes Highway and Princess Freeway.

Council also resolved to rename Mount Ararat North Road and Mount Ararat South Road, on the advice of GNV and based on feedback from emergency services that highlighted concerns around public safety and the confusion caused by duplicated road names.

Council will rename Mount Ararat North Road as Mount Ararat Road, and the report to Council recommended the use of the second most popular name, Alice, as the new name for Mount Ararat South Road.

Bunyip Ward Councillor Graeme Moore moved an alternative motion to rename Mount Ararat South Road as Hannah Road. A submission received by Council during the consultation period requested consideration of the name Hannah, commemorating Hannah Duff, who was one of the few female farmers at the time who owned a property in the area with her husband. Council voted in support of Cr Moore's alternative motion, and Mount Ararat South Road will be renamed Hannah Road, subject to approval from GNV.

Council will work with the Carney family to select a suitable suffix to the suburb name and will inform the community before submitting the full name to GNV for formal approval. Council will also undertake community consultation regarding the renaming of Mount Ararat South Road to Hannah Road.

## Green up Cardinia with Weed Control Grants

Help keep Cardinia green through applying for weed control grants of up to \$1,500\* which are now open for 2024-25.

Available through the Greening Cardinia program, the grants aim to improve biodiversity on private and public land and create habitat for threatened species.

Eligible applicants can be landowners or community groups undertaking works to control high-impact weeds on property located in areas of high environmental value. This can include land near bushland, natural reserves or creeks and rivers.

Landowners on properties over 4,000m<sup>2</sup> (1 acre) and community groups\* may apply for a maximum of \$1,500.

Activities that are eligible include:

- Works that control high-impact weeds on property located in areas of high biodiversity value.
- Purchasing approved chemicals for the required works\* (up to a maximum of \$750 per grant).
- Disposing of weed material (such as tip passes or skip hire).
- The hiring of equipment (such as mulchers).
- Hiring contractors\* (conditions apply; see website for details).
- In addition to the weed control grants, the Greening Cardinia program includes an indigenous plant giveaway (Category 2) and biodiversity incentive community group grants (Category 3).

Cardinia Shire Mayor Councillor Jack Kowarzik encouraged residents and groups to help maintain a green Cardinia.

"The weed control program has been hugely successful in recent years and we are pleased to see it return," Cr Kowarzik said.

"We see great value in these grants and are encouraging all residents and groups, right across the shire, to get involved. The works carried out under this program will provide long-term benefits to the biodiversity of Cardinia."



He did his thesis on this topic and immersed himself in the research of the topic reviewing many old newspapers housed at the State Library. He really enjoyed the research and the discovery of many stories about the people and the authorities involved in the construction of the drainage to make the swamp useful to farm - mainly to grow potatoes.

The KWR swamp was drained between 1889 and 1893 in a depression when jobs needed to be created to get people working. The Main Drain was created, to take the water from the Bunyip River where it joined the swamp south of Bunyip to enter Western Port Bay 25 kms away. The drain was dug by hand.

Many thanks to Gerard for the presentation and the poem to finish. See the summary of Gerard's talk in the Goon News.

Thanks to Danny Kennelly who introduced Gerard. Their lives overlapped in past years - Danny was a student teacher in Gerard's classroom at Pakenham High School where he apparently had the pleasure (not) of delivering a very boring topic to a history class. 



## It's heat pack season! Keep warm safely...

Heat packs, also known as therapeutic wheat bags, are usually a fabric bag filled with wheat or another grain, which is heated in the microwave and used to warm parts of the body.

Heat packs can cause burns and fires if they are poorly designed, badly manufactured or used incorrectly. Only purchase heat bags which have an information sheet and ALWAYS read and follow the directions to limit the risk of injury and fire.

Heat packs can be a fire risk when:

- Overheated in the microwave. Monitor heating and do not heat it for longer than instructed
- When heating the wheat bag, some manufacturers recommend placing a glass of water in the microwave to prevent wheat from drying out.
- Reheated before it has fully cooled
- Used to warm bedding because the bedding material traps the heat. The likelihood of ignition is increased if the wheat bag is insulated with blankets or a quilt.
- Check your wheat bag for damage before (and after) each use, check the material and the stitching.
- Watch for signs of over use, e.g. cooking or burning odours, charring of the bag. If these signs are present dispose of the bag after it has cooled down.
- Do not store away until the wheat bag is cold, this can take up to 2 hours. Always leave the wheat bag to cool on a non-combustible surface
- In addition, burns to the skin may occur with an over-heated wheat bag especially if it is being used on a baby, young child or an elderly person.
