The **Fire Season** will soon be upon us, with expectations that it will be earlier than usual.

So now is the time to prepare your property.

- Clean up around buildings
- Clean gutters
- Move firewood from your home
- Keep grass cut low.
- Prepare safe places for your stock

Review your Fire Plan, ensure that everyone in your household knows the plan and practise what you have decided to do in the event of a fire. Also ensure that we can see your property number from the road so we can find you easily. Can we access your property? We need at LEAST 3m clearance both in width and height for our vehicles.

Now when you have cleaned up you will most likely have quite a lot of waste to deal with. What to do? Well ,a lot of us will decide to burn it! But first check that you are allowed to.

- Check the Cardinia Shire web site, you may need a permit or you may not be allowed to burn off.
- Check the C.F.A. website to check you may need a permit from them or there may be fire restrictions in force.
- Check the weather forecast, particularly for wind speed.
- Make sure that the area around and above the burn off is clear of anything that may burn.
- Tell your neighbours that you are intending to start the burn off and REGISTER it on 1800 668 511 or at burnoffs@esta.vic.gov.au
- Do NOT burn Plastics, Rubber or any hazardous materials.
- Have fire fighting equipment with sufficient water on hand.
- Ensure there is an adult with the burn off at all times and never leave a fire unattended.
- If the worst happens and the burn off gets out of hand and escapes call 000 immediately.
